About ChildSafe: We are a 501(c)3 non-profit treatment center serving survivors of child abuse (primarily sexual abuse) in Northern Colorado for the past 36 years. We treat child victims ages 2-18, adults abused as children, and non-offending family members. We work hard to coordinate our services with outside professionals involved with our families. We believe all survivors should have access to comprehensive, quality services regardless of their financial circumstances.

Our Mission: To break the cycle and heal the trauma resulting from childhood abuse and neglect with specialized treatment, education, and community outreach.

The Position: The ChildSafe team is looking for a Trauma Therapist who will provide counseling to individuals of all ages and families who have experienced child abuse.

- Work location will be primarily our Fort Collins office with some work-from-home opportunities
- 20-25 hours per week. Mon.-Thurs., flexible schedule an option
- Some evening hours are required
- Office space, administrative support, and all supplies are provided

Key Responsibilities:

- Facilitate individual, group, and family sessions as needed for your caseload
- Carry a caseload of 10-12 clients/week with a 50% split between direct and indirect duties
- Complete all case management as required.
- Attend weekly staff meetings, case consultations with co-workers and outside professionals, supervision as needed
- Co-facilitate Trauma Informed Parenting Classes
- Opportunities exist for participation in Multi-Disciplinary committees and work groups

- Minimum one year clinical experience working with trauma survivors
- Minimum of a Master's Degree in the mental health field
- Clinical licensure in Colorado, or working toward licensure
- Self-motivated team player
- Embraces diversity and inclusion
